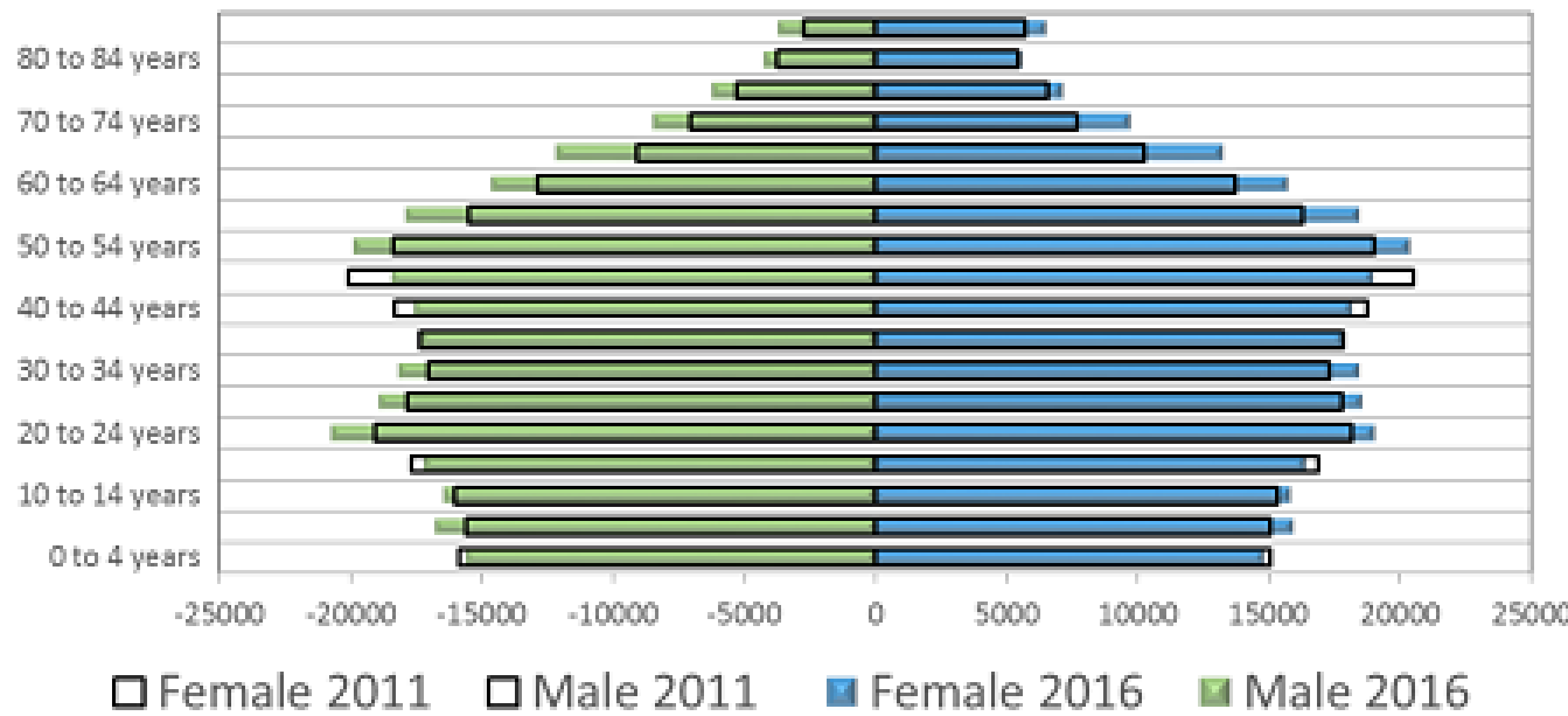


The Aging Population In Waterloo Region

In 2016, **14%** of the population was over the age of 65 - an increase of **21%** since 2011.

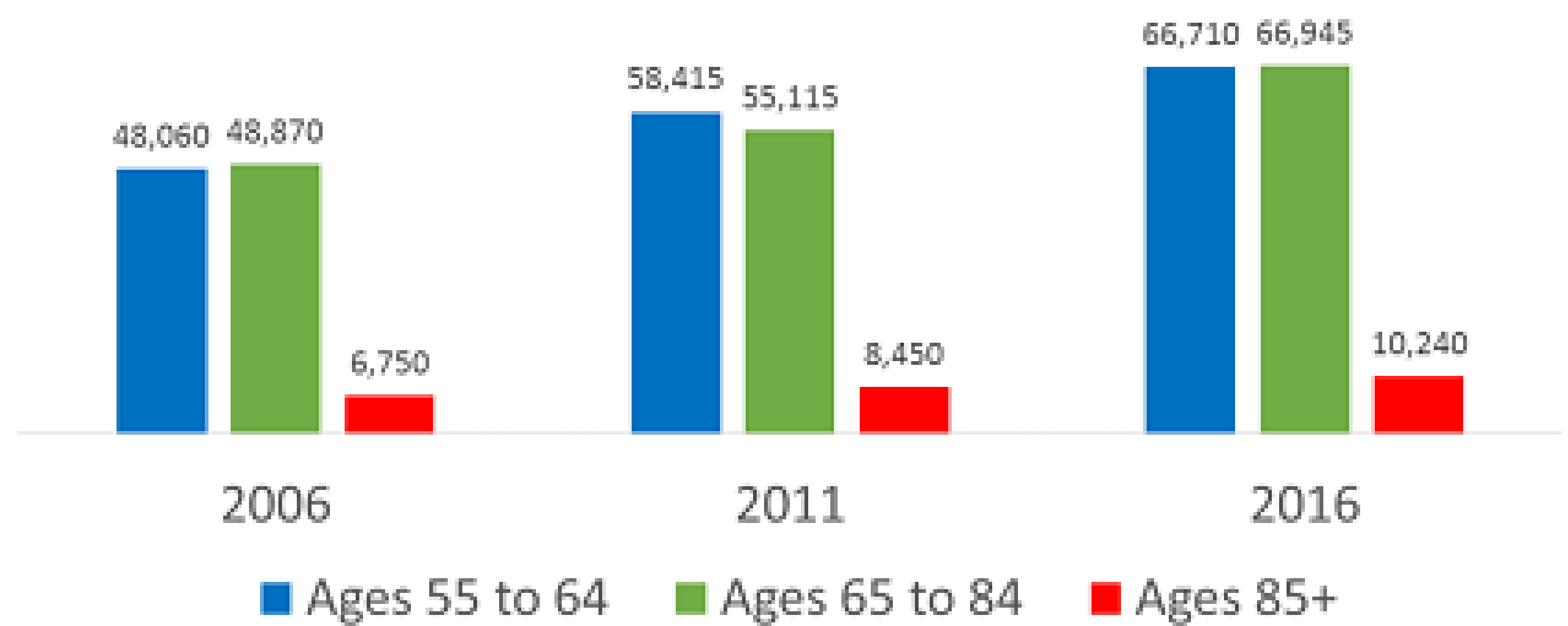
Population in 2011 and 2016 – by sex



Older adults represent our fastest growing age groups

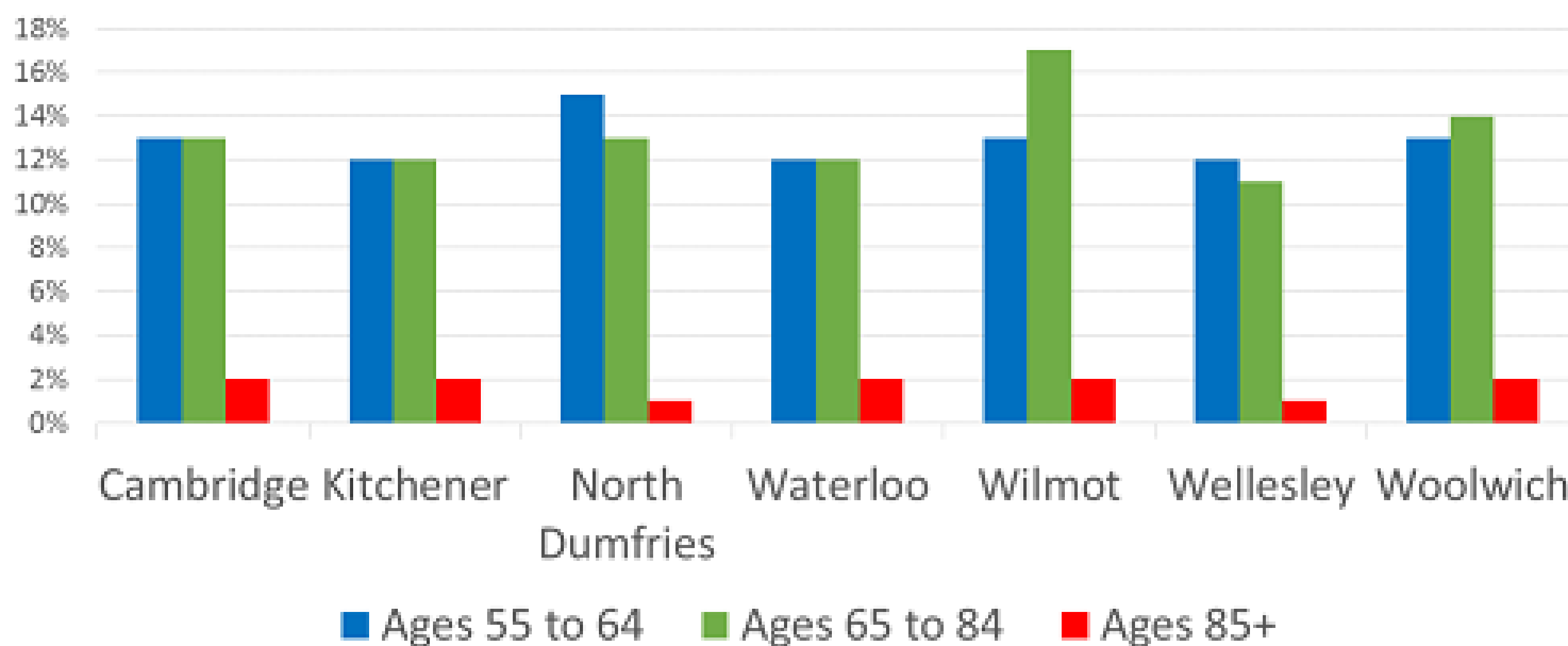
Our population of older adults has increased steadily over time

Population of older adults by municipality



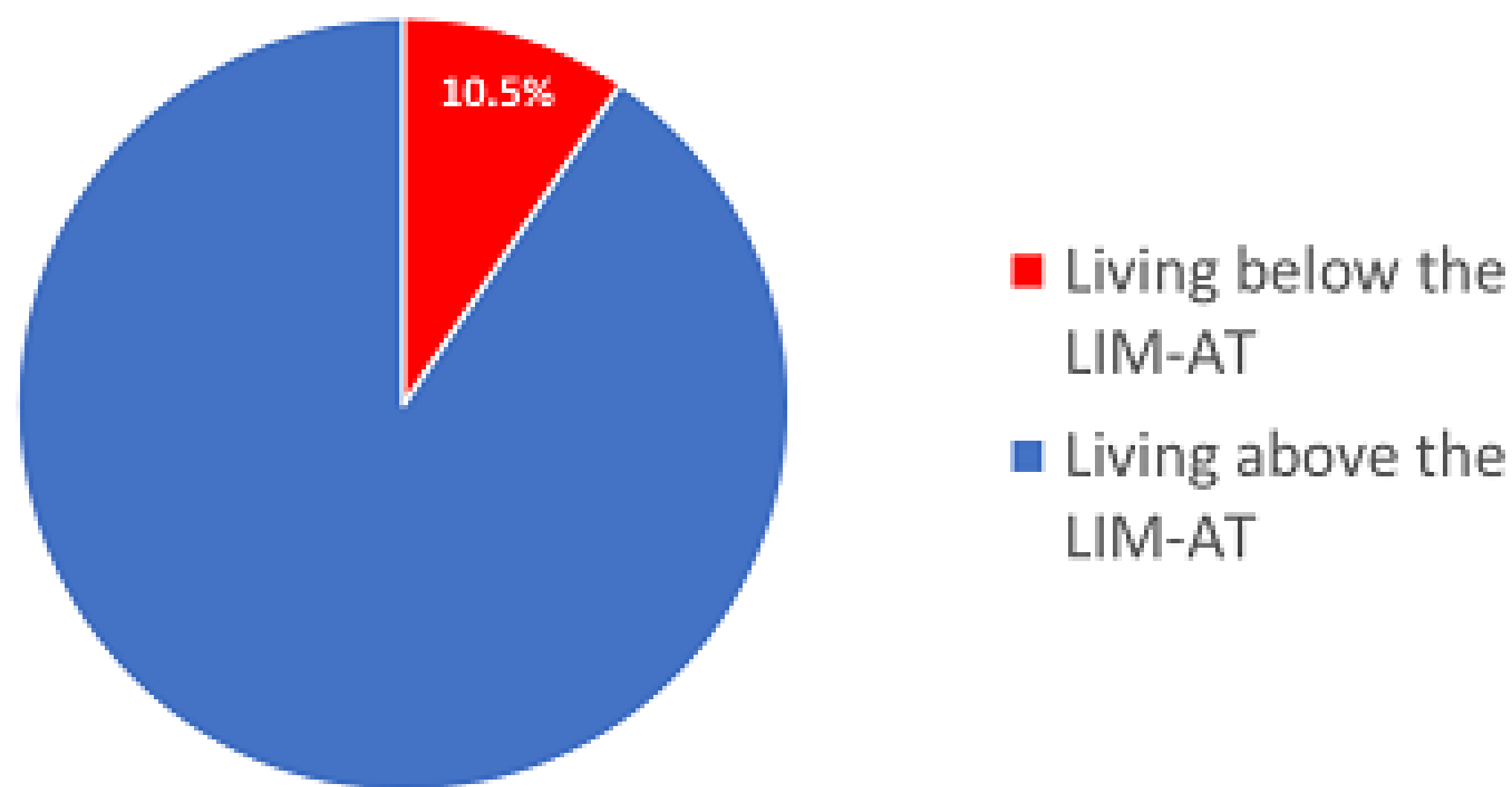
The proportion of older adults varies for each municipality

The after-tax low-income measure (LIM-AT) is \$22,460 for a one-person household.

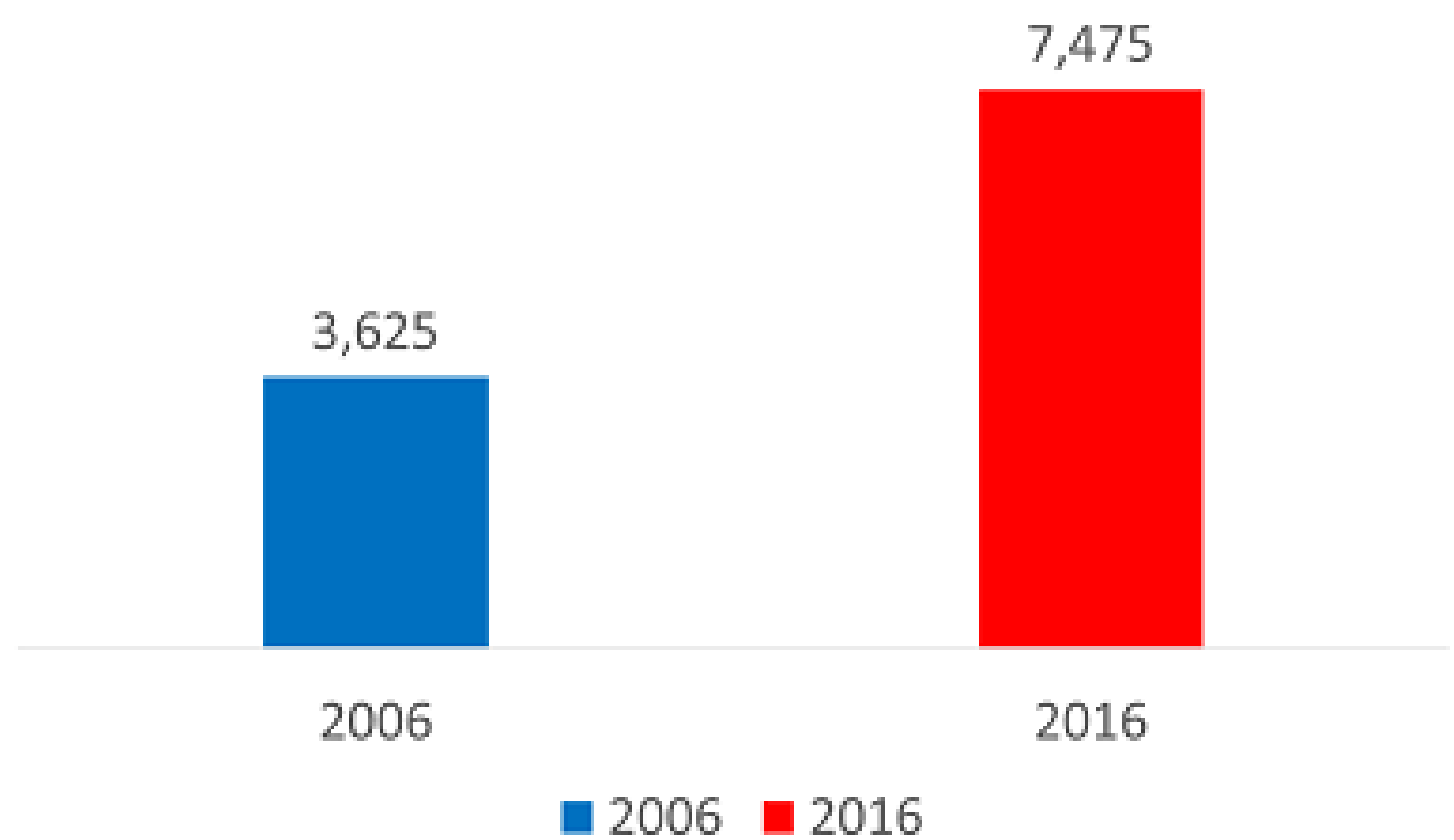
Population age 65 and over by LIM-AT status



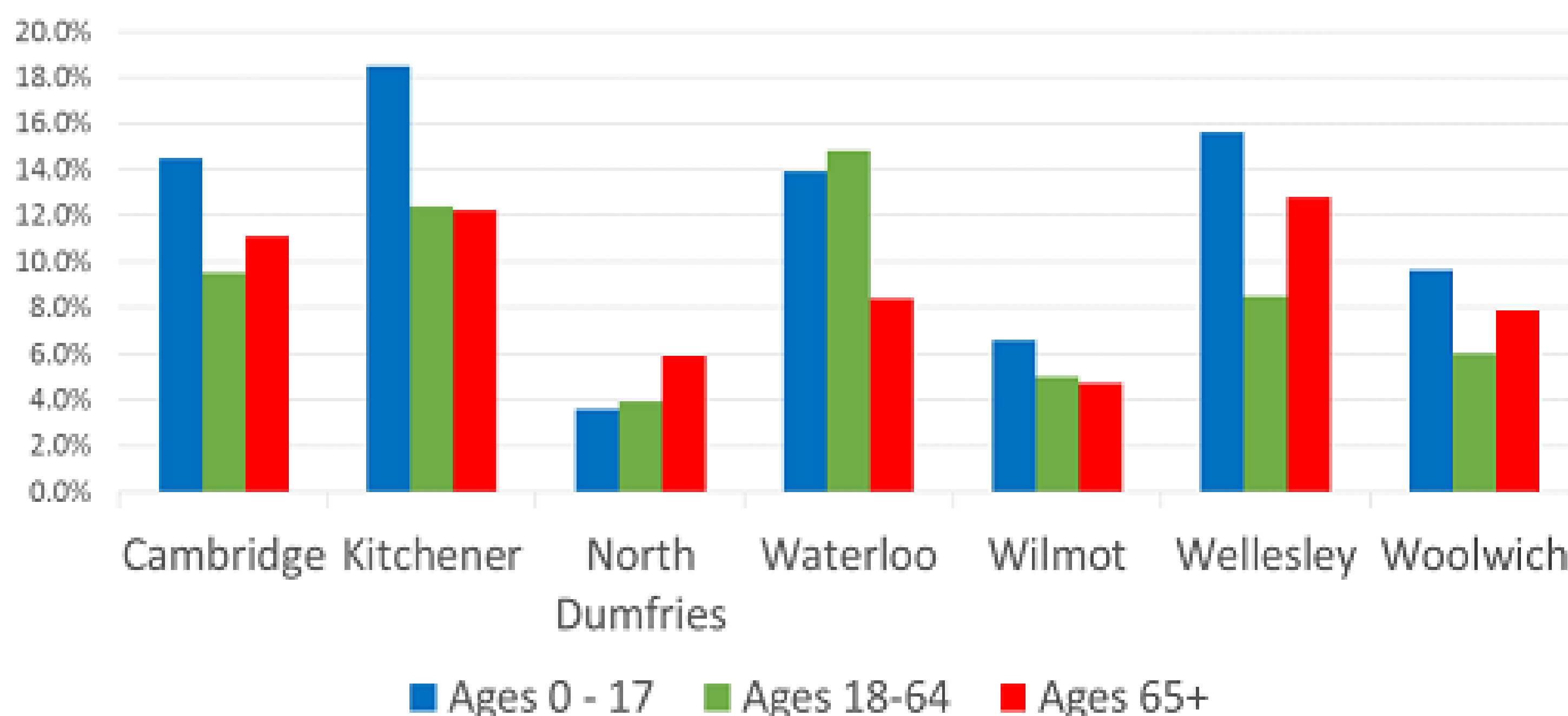
In 2016, **10.5%** of seniors over 65 lived below the LIM-AT
