## The Demographics

The 5-9 year old age group is the most populous.



This group represents 9.2% of the population, or 1,035 people.

The fastest growing group is the 70 to 74 age group.



This group has increased by 33.3% since 2011.

Population of 11,260 in 2016



The Population has increased by 5.1% since 2011

Children age 0-14 represent 26.6% of the population.



This is higher than the national (16.6%) and provincial (16.4%) averages.

The median age is 33.7 years.



This is up from 32.3 years in 2011.

## The Realities

### Work



18.8% of the employed labor force are in trades, transport and equipment operators and related occupations.

17% are in management occupations.

### Food



In Waterloo Region, the cost of eating healthy for a family of four in 2017 was \$835.43 per month.

This is a 3.1% decrease from 2016.

#### Income



The median after-tax family income for lone parent families in 2015 was \$60,800.

For couple families with children it was \$105,509, and \$78,007 for those without children.

#### **Education**



20.6% of adults age 25-64 have a high school education.

45.7% have a post-secondary education.

33.7% have no certificate, degree or diploma.

5.8% of families are lone-parent



Lone-parent families make approximately \$44,700 less than couple-with-children families.



73.5% of lone-parents are female.



11.2% of the population, or 1,265 people, are living at or below the Low Income Measure - After-Tax Line.



555 of these people are children under 18.
